## COVID-19 Standard Response Protocol

<p>STAGE</p> 	<p><b>PREVENTION: No confirmed cases of COVID-19 among staff or students</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Health prevention measures are in place</li> <li>• Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning of facilities</li> <li>• No or limited visitor access</li> <li>• Monitoring of virus trends in the community via local health officials</li> <li>• Communicate to employees and district community</li> </ul>
<p>STAGE</p> 	<p><b>MITIGATION: One or more confirmed case(s) of COVID-19 at one facility.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Person(s) with close contact of an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19 will be advised to self-quarantine for 14 days (per Health authorities)</li> <li>• Affected area is closed for deep cleaning</li> <li>• Self-monitoring, preventative measure and stay home if ill</li> <li>• No visitor access</li> <li>• Communicate to employees and district community</li> </ul>
<p>STAGE</p> 	<p><b>MODIFIED OPERATIONS: Three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases in one specific area or campus.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students and staff of that area may need to self-quarantine for 14 days.</li> <li>• Students impacted will move to remote learning from home</li> <li>• Affected area will be closed for deep cleaning</li> <li>• Self-monitoring, preventative measures and stay home if ill</li> <li>• No visitor access on open campuses</li> <li>• Communicate to employees and district community</li> </ul>
<p>STAGE</p> 	<p><b>CAMPUS CLOSURE: COVID-19 cases exceed 10% of facility occupancy.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Entire campus will be closed for a minimum of two days</li> <li>• Students and staff may return if symptom free upon determination by the school district administration and health authorities</li> <li>• Those in close contact with the confirmed COVID-19 positive person(s) will quarantine for 14 days per CDC</li> <li>• No visitor access on open campuses</li> <li>• Communication to employees and community with health monitoring guidelines.</li> </ul>
<p>STAGE</p> 	<p><b>DISTRICT CLOSURE: COVID-19 cases exceed 10% occupancy within ALL campuses.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Lorenzo ISD facilities closed for a time determined by Health Dept.</li> <li>• Students and staff move to remote learning and work</li> <li>• All facilities and buses are deep cleaned and disinfected</li> <li>• All areas, such as playgrounds, gyms, and athletic facilities are closed</li> <li>• Extracurricular activities, contests, trips, events will be cancelled</li> <li>• Communicate to employees and district community</li> </ul>

This chart serves as a guide for decision making for COVID-19. Understanding that things can change rapidly, decisions may be adjusted as the situation is fluid. If cases are isolated to a specific grade or program, a more isolated approach may be adopted. Any Governor's Order supersedes this chart.
